

We Minister Beyond Our Walls

The Outreach Ministry provides opportunities for the congregation to actively participate in outreach and mission projects to spread God's love in the world.

Our church donates \$29,250 directly to local and international ministries like CARITAS, CCHASM, Friends of the Homeless, Habitat for Humanity, HomeAgain, Haiti Reforestation Partnership, Westminster Canterbury Foundation and Cindy Corell, the Presbyterian Missionary in Haiti.

We also support the greater church. The \$30,000 Covenant our church has with the Presbytery provides resources to do its work and supports ministries beyond our Presbytery in the Synod and the General Assembly. These gifts further support all the various ministries provided by the Presbytery such as Collegiate Ministries, Presbyterian Women, Camp Hanover, Disaster Relief, Haiti, and fourteen others.

Outreach to our community and the world would not be possible without the caring and professional staff that ministers to, supports and works with us. Our facilities make it possible to host various community groups, stage supplies and learn how to serve others.

We Worship and Make Music

The ministry provides for the worship of the people of God at Salisbury Presbyterian Church, which includes the preaching of the Word, the sharing of the sacraments, and celebration through music ministry. The Worship & Music Ministry is supported by guilds that provide specific assistance in the following areas: Sacristy, Ushering, Acolyte, Flowers, Lay Leaders, Weddings, and Sound. The guilds provide an opportunity for church members of all ages to volunteer and participate in worship at Salisbury Presbyterian.

Music Ministry is a vital part of how we worship and connect the gospel with the community. This ministry supports music ensembles, Chancel Choir, Sunrise Singers, Salisbury Ringers, Children's Choirs, Youth Choir, Jubilation, Music Academy and hosts Joyful Voices. The Music Ministry is led by one full and 8 part-time professionals. Our choirs have been invited to perform at National Presbyterian Church, the Washington National Cathedral, Carnegie Hall, St. Giles Cathedral in Edinburgh, and have been the featured choir several times on the Bruton Parish Candlelight Concert Series

To support our efforts the Sanctuary, offices and spaces are professionally managed. We are committed to continuous maintenance, cleaning and upgrades to church buildings and systems to support our growing ministry. To help ensure a safe Sanctuary we have replaced the HVAC system and installed air filtration. We have invested in disinfecting equipment and supplies that comply with CDC/EPA guidelines.



We Learn about Christ

Salisbury's Christian Education & Discipleship ministry provides opportunities for children, youth, and adults to learn about Christ through Bible study, faith-based curriculum, discussion and small groups, fellowship, service, and frequent interaction with each other.

Soon, a new Associate Pastor for CE&D will join us in ministry to lead with professional, spiritual guidance. The F&E and A&E buildings provide safe and comfortable spaces for Christian learning for all ages. Classrooms are appointed with the materials and technology to support a vibrant learning environment.

Salisbury Presbyterian Preschool was organized in August 1984 and has been operated by our church since. The preschool occupies the A&E building and continues to be a vital part of the church's ministry. We employ 25 teaching and support staff, as well as 2 administrators. The school is at capacity of 151 children. Our goal is to provide a high-quality program that will promote each child's social, emotional, physical, intellectual, and spiritual well-being. Christian values and principles are shared daily through learning activities.

We Nurture Families and Youth

Youth Ministry at SPC provides a safe, welcoming community where youth, their families, and friends can share their faith, build relationships, and develop their unique gifts to serve God and others. We do this by offering a diversity of ministry experiences that prepare our youth for lifelong discipleship through worship, fellowship, prayer, study, and mission. The ministry is led by Reverend Nate Taylor who joined us in the fall of 2020.

The ministry makes full use of our facilities from office space, the gym, and dedicated gathering space in the F&E hall. The ministry uses the church van for mission trips and outings. The F&E hall and kitchen serves as a place where families gather together for fellowship breakfasts, dinners, receptions, and events.

This ministry includes Congregational Care that helps members experience the love of Christ within our church family. Funerals, Care & Concern, Loaves and Fishes, Prayer Requests, Sharing Sunshine and Visitations are a few of the ways that we care for each other.

Families and relationships are strengthened by our Fellowship Ministry. This ministry creates opportunities for our church members to strengthen one another and to be strengthened in faith through fellowship.
